## **TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION**

### **Getting to the hotel from the airport**

When you arrive at Easterwood Airport in College Station on Sunday June 6th, there are three options for getting to the Hilton:

1. Take the Symposium Shuttle, which will run at regular intervals. (*The driver will be holding up a sign saying North Symposium ...*)
2. Call the Hilton at 979-693-750 to request the complimentary shuttle that runs from 7am to 11pm
3. Take a taxi. City taxis are usually available in front of the terminal on the lower level. If none are there, you can call one at:
